



Inclement Weather

Temperature is based on the estimated temperature via the Bureau of Meteorology (Elizabeth). Teachers can check the temperature the night before and make decisions based on the estimated temperature for the Elizabeth (Munno Para West) area and inform parents of cancellations.

If the estimated temperature is **35°C or above** for Elizabeth the following will apply:

Excursions

- 1. School excursions cancelled.
- 2. Swimming for R-12 classes cancelled.
- 3. <u>Local indoor</u> excursions can go ahead (e.g., Bowland or local library) if transport arrangements and venues have suitable air-conditioning.
- 4. Swimming to Strathmont Centre and Barossa Aquatic and Fitness (The Rex) Tanunda can continue, however, will be cancelled if estimated temperature is **36°C or above**.

Outdoor Play

- Leadership will decide on inside play on days where the temperature is approaching 35°C.
- Pathways Classes will follow their local school procedures, however will need to make decisions based on the increased risk to vulnerable students.
- Units will decide on inside play if inclement weather is an issue. Unit Rep or Proxy to communicate decision to Front Office personnel, who will notify relevant staff.
- Pathways Classes will follow their local school procedures regarding inclement weather play.

In severe inclement weather conditions, Site Leadership will review the situation and make a daily decision regarding outdoor play, local walks and excursions.

If a staff member, in consultation with Site Leadership, considers that the students are at risk by attending an excursion in temperatures <u>below</u> those stipulated above, or where the weather conditions are problematic, the outing may be cancelled.
